Examples

We have a **small** car.

I saw a **white** bird.

She watched an **old** film.

Remember!

Adjectives don't have a plural form.

We have two **small** cars.

I saw five **white** birds.

She watched some **old** films.

Be careful!

Size before colour.

We have a **small, blue** car.

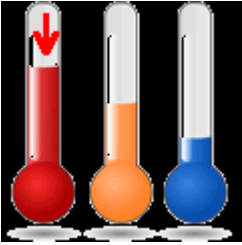
I saw a **large, white** bird.

We say... We don't say...

We have a small, blue car. (NOT We have a small and blue car.)

I saw five large, white birds. (NOT I saw five large and white birds.)
